

What is Kairos Outside?

Kairos Outside offers a comfortable, non-judging retreat for women to support each other as they journey through the impact of their own incarceration or that of a friend or loved one. In this caring setting, women with similar challenges share their common stories and draw on each other for strength, forming a Christian community.



How is a Kairos Outside Weekend Formatted?

The Kairos Outside weekend format is based on the Cursillo, Walk to Emmaus, Via de Cristo, and other such movements, which consists of a series of talks by women who share their life journey. After each talk, there is time for guests and team to review it in small groups. The program is interspersed with music, fun activities, good food, and general pampering. The weekend begins Friday evening about 6:00 p.m. and concludes on Sunday at about 3:00 p.m. The weekend is presented by an ecumenical team who volunteer their time, talent, and treasure to provide a safe place for women to develop a supportive network.

Is Kairos Outside Only Found in Washington?

Kairos Outside is part of Kairos Prison Ministry International (KPMI), whose mission is to share the transforming love and forgiveness of Jesus Christ to impact the hearts and lives of incarcerated men, women and youth, as well as their families. The ministries of KPMI are found in 472 prisons and communities, in 10 countries, with volunteers donating 3 million hours of their time.

How Can You Get Involved?



- **Volunteer:** There are two ways to volunteer—team member and Day Angel. Team members are required to attend 36 hours of training, as well as the weekend and reunions. Day Angels can volunteer for various shifts throughout the weekend. Volunteers can be of any gender. Men and Day Angels work in the background. Minimum age for team members: 18 years old. Minimum age for Day Angels: 16 years old.
- **Be or invite a guest:** Guests are women who have been impacted by incarceration—their own, a loved one, or friend, and have not attended a Kairos Inside or Outside. The weekend is free for the guest. Transportation, childcare reimbursement, and special accommodations are provided for guests who require them. Minimum age for guests: 20 years old.
- **Donate:** Weekends cost approximately \$75 person (guests and team). We do not ask team members to pay to participate or guests to pay to attend. What we do is raise money through donations from individuals, churches, and businesses as well as various fundraisers, such as meal tickets, ticketed drawings, and staffing a rest stop on I-90.
