Now, besides helping you here, we also want to let you know how we can help you in some other ways...

How many of you have someone, a female family member or a friend, who loves you and who has been supporting you while you have been incarcerated?

It is often said, your family members and your friends do time right along with you – and as you all know, much better than we do, life can be very difficult and stressful for them.

And, they have a lot going on - right? ...

They must manage working, taking care of kids, coming to visit, being available for your phone calls, making sure you have money on your books, and many other things

And maybe some of you have female loved ones or a friend that is angry at you because you are here, and your relationship with them has been damaged...

How would like to give those ladies the opportunity to be a part of the Kairos community, the same Kairos community that you are now a part of?

How would you like for them to experience God's grace and His forgiveness, and to feel the same love, hope and support that you have felt this Weekend?

How would you like to make your relationship with them better, or to fix or restore a broken relationship with them?

Well, we have an opportunity for you to do that.

There is an opportunity for you, and your family, to experience some or all the things I have mentioned by inviting your female family member or loved one to attend a Kairos Outside Weekend.

Kairos Outside is one of the other programs conducted by Kairos Prison Ministry, International.

Kairos Outside was started because a Chaplain at San Quentin, after the first Kairos Weekend there, felt the inmates who became involved with Kairos were open to family unity.

So, he asked Kairos to develop a program that would minister to the female family members and friends of the incarcerated.

You will receive more information about how you can invite your loved ones and friends to attend a Kairos Outside Weekend. And if for some reason you don't, talk with the Chaplain, or the Kairos volunteers the next time you see them. They will be happy to help you.

[Gentlemen/Ladies], as one Guest said, "Kairos Outside was the greatest gift my brother ever gave me, and there are not many gifts or things that an inmate can do for his/her family from the inside", she went on to say, "I have had a front row seat to watch to watch God at work in the life of my brother and in my family through Kairos..."

[Gentlemen/Ladies] you and your loved ones or friends can have the same experience that she talked about.

I want to encourage you to pray about inviting your loved ones and friends to attend a Kairos Outside Weekend

The Weekend is free –

We provide transportation...

We do the program all over the world - so even if your loved one or friend lives somewhere else we can probably find a Kairos Outside Weekend close by...

Who do you need in your life to support you, and who in your life needs to have support?

He comes alongside us when we go through hard times, and before you know it, he brings us alongside someone else who is going through hard times so that we can be there for that person just as God was there for us.
